THE CLEANING OF THE "OLIFA" VARNISH ON THE RUSSIAN ICONS

PRINCIPAL INTERVENANT : Elena Azarnina, conservator in the State Russian Museum, Saint-Petersbourg.

The workshop will be held in the ARC'ANTIQUE laboratory in Nantes, France :

- Presentation of the chemical composition of the "olifa" varnish.
- History of the *"olifa"* removal techniques practiced in Russia.
- Current techniques for the removal of the "olifa" varnish.
- Discussion and exchange of the methods practiced on the same subject by participants working in other countries.
- Conclusion of the exchanges.

Participants will work on icons which have *"olifa"* varnish. The samples of varnish will have been analysed before the workshop. During the workshop, icons will be photographed under U.V., X-Ray and I.R. light in the ARC'ANTIQUE laboratory.


